New Arrival Refugee Immunisation Program

The NARI Program aims to provide a coordinated approach to the assessment and delivery of immunisations for newly arrived refugees to South Australia. The program provides accessible immunisation services for refugees in the areas they have settled.

A NARI provider can:

- Receive and discuss referrals from GPs and other health professionals
- Assess the current immunisation status of all new arrivals, developing catch-up programs as required
- Provide documentation of the immunisations given and when the immunisations are next due
- Provide access to interpreting services for new arrivals attending the clinics
- Make appointments for individuals and family groups
