*3.2 There shall be the following classes of Members of the Association:

3.2.1 General Practice Members:

- (a) Natural persons who are medical practitioners and who reside and/or actively practise in General Practice in the General Practice Network South area and are registered as General Practitioners for the purposes of the Medical Practice Act 2004.
- (b) Practice Nurses who actively practice in General Practice in the General Practice Network South area.
- (c) General Practice Medical Research and Training Members: Persons who are general practice registrars or professors or associate professors of general practice, and who reside and/or study, work as a registrar, or teach general practice in the General Practice Network South area.

3.2.2 Associate Members:

Natural persons who are registered as specialists for the purposes of the Medical Practice Act 2004, and who actively practice in the General Practice Network South area, or who are general practitioners but who do not reside or actively practice in the General Practice Network South area, or who are medical students PROVIDED THAT Associate members may not be elected as Board Members or vote at Annual or Special General Meetings.
