An important aim of the Chronic Disease Community Program (CDCP) is to increase the range and accessibility of Allied Health services in the community.

What Allied Health Services are available through the CDCP?

- Physiotherapy
- Occupational Therapy
- Podiatry
- Speech Pathology
- Nutrition and Dietetics
- Social Work
- Diabetes Nurse Educator

How long is the wait?

You will be seen within two weeks of your referral being received.

What will you receive?

The CDCP funds a short start up Allied Health service that aims to give you some skills to better self manage your condition, and to determine your future needs.

The Medicare Plus Allied Health program may also be an option for you. Assistance can be provided to access this program through your GP if required.
