What services are available to you?

An individual assessment and follow up is provided and can include:

- Diabetes Assessment and Management review
- Discussion and identification of your goals for diabetes management
- Education on diabetes management
- Assist in the development of self management skills
- Providing information about useful links to the community

What cost?

There are no costs to you for these services, which include an individual assessment and follow up

Where?

Diabetes Nurse Educator services as part of the Program are available in your own home

What happens after this visit?

Following your Diabetes Nurse Educator service a letter will be sent to your GP outlining any findings and recommendations for future care.

As a result of this service

- You may develop goals and strategies to improve your diabetes management at home
- You may be provided with connections to community based services that provide diabetes management
- Your GP may refer you for further services through the normal channels
